The June paint-in is Miss Freckles Frog designed by Wendy Fahey and taught by Bonnie Dominguez. More information to come.

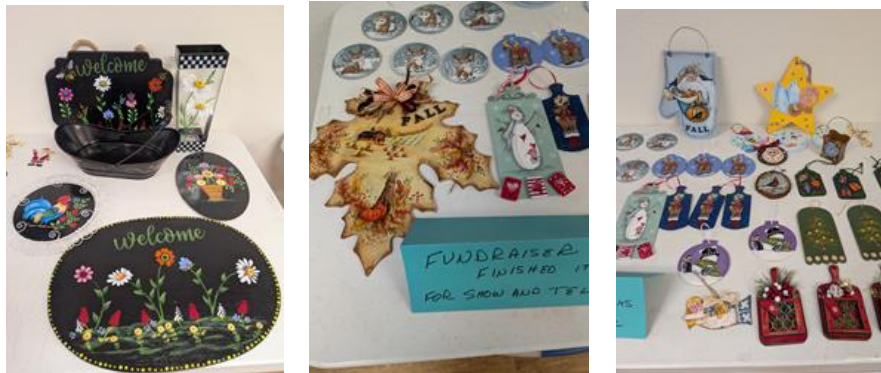

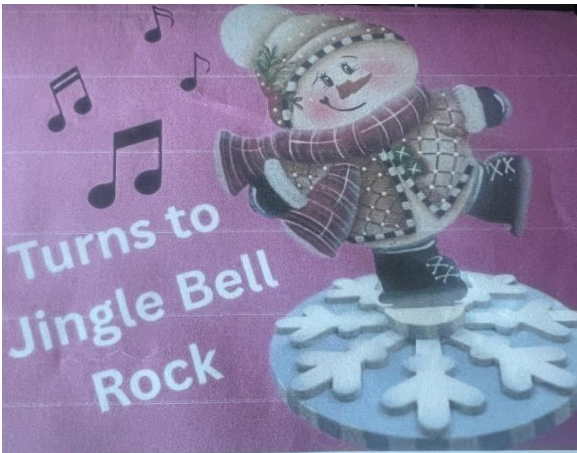
## Friday May 1
